CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, windmill and pump jack for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T.16N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 28 bears N. 70° 40' E., a distance of 3,273.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0011 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 25, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well thence is pumped by a windmill and jack pump thence, via a distribution system, to three (3) 250 gallon stockwatering troughs where 200 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 28, T.16N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
