CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Spring #17
through a developed spring and distribution system for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 18, T.38N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears S. 69° 30' 00" W., a distance of 969.92 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 19, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is produced from a developed spring thence flows into an open ditch within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 18, T.38N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., where 500 head of cattle water.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
