CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. S. Van Kirk, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Geothermal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T.4S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 8 bears N. 85° 34' W., a distance of 1,152.90 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Caliente, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.027 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.37 million gallons annually  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 20, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Hot water is produced from a 115 foot deep well, 6 inch casing, thence conveyed through a distribution system where the water is used to heat a single-family home within a portion of Block 47 of the North side addition of the Town of Caliente within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 8, T.4S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
