CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arnold C. Wood, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a well, pump and distribution system for Mining, Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T.16N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears N. 25° 02' 38" W., a distance of 1,712.37 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.1181 c.f.s., but not to exceed 20.609 million gallons per season
Period of use, from March 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a well thence is conveyed by a 2-inch plastic pipeline 950 feet to the place of use within the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 18, T.16N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., where the water is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
