CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through cleaned out spring area and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T.43N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 20 bears N. 73° 02' E., a distance of 4,791.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Harold K. and Sandra P. Boggio
Post-office address Paradise Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0067 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 250 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 27, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a spring area which has been cleaned out, thence the water is piped 6 feet by a 1-1/2 inch plastic pipe to a stockwatering trough, which is a barrel cut in half, which is 23 inches in diameter, 17 inches high and holds 27 gallons of water. The place of use is SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, T.43N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., where 250 head of cattle are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
