CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George M. Wilson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 09° 09' 50" E., a distance of 747.92 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.260 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in a 57 foot deep, 6 inch casing well, thence is conveyed via a pressure tank. One main line is piped to a single house and the other line is piped 91 feet to the milling operation. The water is used for milling and domestic purposes within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 14, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
