CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. P. Osgood, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ground Hog Spring through a developed spring for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 27 bears N. 24° 20' W., a distance of 274.4 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 5, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring area known as Ground Hog Spring rises in an open pool about 30 feet in diameter and about 3 feet deep. The water from the pool is used for stockwater for about 200 head of cattle within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 27, T.21N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
