CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cricket Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.39N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 29 bears S. 59° 09' 21" E., a distance of 3,657.59 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 19, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a developed spring known as Cricket Spring. The water flows into a 1/4 inch pipeline, 200 feet long to a 4 foot by 10 foot by 2 foot deep stockwatering trough. 300 Head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29, T.39N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
