CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Millard G. Reed, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation (Golf Course) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 20 bears S. 76° 56' 33" E., a distance of 2,960.35 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.62 c.f.s., but not to exceed 277.72 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 22, 1974

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and 9 columns for acreage and section details. Includes rows for 1.92 Acres, 27.35, 19.82, 7.85, 2.20, 6.00, 4.59, and a total of 69.73 Acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
