CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan F. Walter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 31 bears N. 85° 43' 37" E., a distance of 1,272.29 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.13 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,542.05 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1939

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and storage transmission and distribution system and is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the service area of the Las Vegas Valley Water District in Clark County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 10458, Certificate 2828, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 10458, Certificate 2828.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
