CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy A. Hatcher, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (River Bottom Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.46N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 6, T.45N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 60° 08' 20" E., a distance of 5,088.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 24, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well, 6 inch casing with a 1 inch discharge, 3/4 horsepower submersible pump and motor, thence the water is conveyed to two (2) 3 feet by 22 feet half round stockwatering troughs and one (1) 50 foot diameter pond within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 31, T.46N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. The water is used for stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
