CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Mining, Milling and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T.35N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 10 bears S. 52° 58' 59" W., a distance of 861.54 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Polar Resources Co.
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.16 c.f.s., but not to exceed 20.938 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 2, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution system which consists of 2600 feet of 3 inch pipeline where the water is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes within a portion of the E 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 10, T.35N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
