CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Coyote Well) through a drilled well and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T.3N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 30, T.2N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 36° 58' 15" E., a distance of 50,414.84 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Imperial Farms Land & Cattle Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Pioche, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0044 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 450 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 18, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in a drilled well thence conveyed, via a distribution system, to two (2) stockwatering troughs, the overflow feeds into an earth filled reservoir 180 feet long by 85 feet wide and 5 feet deep where 450 head of cattle water within Section 20, T.3N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
