CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (South Hamlin or Windmill Well) through a drilled well and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2, T.6N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 2 bears S. 43° 13' E., a distance of 1,678.48 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0044 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 537 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Improvements consist of a drilled well equipped with a windmill and Jensen walking-beam pump. Water is piped to a series of 5 steel stockwatering troughs 10-1/2 feet long by 4-1/2 feet in diameter where 537 head of cattle are watered within Section 2, T.6N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
