CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Feed Lot Well #1) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 1 bears S. 88° 40' 59" W., a distance of 2,610.69 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Elko Land and Livestock Company
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0625 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 2,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 3, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution system which consists of 2120 feet of 4 inch pipeline, 6,240 feet of 2 inch laterals which feed 36 concrete troughs 2 feet by 2 feet and 10 concrete troughs, 2 feet by 3 feet, where 2,000 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 1, T.33N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
