CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.26N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 1, T.25N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 47° 21' E., a distance of 119.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Altamira Farms
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.745 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,162.0 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from: March 1st to November 30th of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: June 9, 1960

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: (SEE ATTACHED SHEET)

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 18915, Certificate 6137, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 18915, Certificate 6137.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
