CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. H. Craven has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through a well, pump and distribution system for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 2 bears N. 38° 52' 30" W., a distance of 1,535.9 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. H. Craven
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00446 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.526 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 16, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system for watering of fruit trees, shade trees and lawn, for one (1) household use, within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
