CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bowman Creek/Triple T Reservoir through a creek, reservoir and distribution system Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, T.15N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 19 bears N. 12° 36' E., a distance of 2,079.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from November 1st to May 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 25, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted into a constructed pond 200 feet long, 100 feet wide and 12 feet deep within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 19, T.15N., R.44E., M.D.B.&M., where 200 head of cattle water.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
