CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard L. Carver, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well and distribution system for Fish Pond and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.11N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 29 bears S. 44° 35' 10" W., a distance of 1,697.27 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 22, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 500 feet deep, which serves two (2) ponds within a portion of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29. A pipeline serves the ranch house for the domestic use purpose.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
