CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl Harriman, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T.18N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 17, T.18N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 38° 34' 28" W., a distance of 7,646.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0019 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 60 head of cattle
Period of use, from November 1st to March 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 19, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and distribution system which serves three (3) stockwatering troughs, two (2) four feet by ten feet by three feet and one (1) four feet by four feet by three feet. The water is used for stockwatering for 60 head of cattle within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 20, T.18N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
