CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy Clifford, Partner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring #1 through a developed spring, ditch and ponds for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 10, T.7N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 34, T.8N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 9° 48' 11" W., a distance of 9,782.21 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Albina Clifford, Roy Clifford, Joe Clifford, Jr., and Marguerite Boscouich, D.B.A. Stone Cabin Partnership. Post-office address: Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0159 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle and 10 head of horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: July 5, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is a developed spring area which is diverted from the spring by a ditch which runs into a pond where water is used for 500 head of cattle and 10 head of horses within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, all in Section 10, T.7N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
