CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lincoln "Nick" Mansfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Biddleman Spring through a developed spring, pond and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T.19N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 29 bears N. 27° 33' E., a distance of 3,516.0 feet situated in Storey County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation December 6, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a spring, known as the Biddleman Spring, which flows into a pond 20 feet by 30 feet, thence is piped by a 1-1/2 inch pipe to a stockwatering trough, where 100 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 29, T.19N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the manner of use and place of use of a portion of Permit 30879, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 30879.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
