CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 10 bears N. 04° 53' 40" E., a distance of 1,397.26 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bell Telephone Company of Nevada
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0396 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.011 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 19, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, thence conveyed by a distribution system which serves a humidifier within a commercial building to keep electronic equipment at a constant relative humidity. The place of use is within a portion of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 10, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
