CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard L. Hafen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T.14S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 Corner of Section 16, T.14S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 02° 44' 22" W., a distance of 3,491.30 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Corporation of the Presiding Bishop of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints
Post-office address: Salt Lake City, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.302 c.f.s., but not to exceed 65.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: April 28, 1965

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 13.0 Acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, T.14S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 22559, Certificate 9606, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 22559, Certificate 9606.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
