CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source Well #3 through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2, Section 11, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 14, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 3° 03' 05" E., a distance of 2,098.40 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from March 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 28, 1976

\*This certificate is issued with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
