CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Well No. 3) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 2, Section 11, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 14, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 03° 03' 05" E., a distance of 2,098.40 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 28, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed 1,950 feet by a 1-1/2 inch pipeline to three (3) stockwatering troughs, 9 feet in diameter by 2 feet deep. The place of use is within Lot 2, Section 11, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., where 500 head of cattle are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
