CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Dry Gulch Well) through windmill and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T.37N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 34 bears S. 53° 45' 00" E., a distance of 2809.85 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.012 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 10, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, equipped with a windmill, thence is piped by a 1-1/4 inch pipeline 11 feet to a stockwater trough, 20 feet in diameter by 2 feet in depth. The overflow runs into a small earth pond where 400 head of cattle are watered within the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 34, T.37N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
