CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Don Nonella, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lime Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T.16N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 5 bears N. 77° 13' W., a distance of 450.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator 7-C Ranch Inc.

Post-office address Eastgate, Fallon, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 6, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water flows from the spring area by a 20 foot in length pipeline into a 300 gallon stockwater trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, T.16N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
