WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3, Section 31, T.48N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 31 bears N. 74° 10' E., a distance of 3,164.0 feet

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

1,000 Head of cattle water along the stream course of Sage Creek. The place of use is as follows: Lots 1, 2, 3, Section 31; Lots 3, 4, Section 32; Lots 1, 2, 3, Section 33; Lot 4, Section 34; Lots 1, 2, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35; S 1/2 S 1/2 Section 36, all in T.48N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M.; Lots 2, 3, 4, Section 6, T.47N., R.35E.; E 1/2 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31; N 1/2 S 1/2 Section 32, all in T.48N., R.35E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
