CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Corral Canyon Creek through Corral Canyon Creek, along the water course for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3, Section 6, T.47N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 4, T.47N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 71° 23' E., a distance of 12,628.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 25, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
1,000 Head of cattle water along the stream course of Corral Canyon Creek. The place of use is as follows: Portion of Lot 3, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6; S 1/2 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4, all in Section 5; N 1/2 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4, all in Section 4; Lot 1, 2, 3, and S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 3; Lots 3, 4, Section 2, in T.47N., R.34E., and SE 1/4 SW 1/4, S 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 35, T.48N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
