CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy A. Hatcher, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Daveytown Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T.39N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 7, T.39N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 43° 18' E., a distance of 3,241.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 20, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, equipped with a windmill, thence the water is conveyed by a 2 inch pipeline to a 30 foot in diameter stockwatering trough where 200 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.39N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
