CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bruce L. Rice, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T.23N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 30 bears S. 57° 10' E., a distance of 184.0 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 2.7 c.f.s., but not to exceed 508.8 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year

31.8 Acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, T.23N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.
31.8 Acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, T.23N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.
127.2 Acres Total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
