CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring No. 5 through a spring and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, T.44N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 11 bears N. 81° 37' 27" E., a distance of 5048.37 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 10, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from an improved spring with two (2) cement wings to channel the water through 1,500 feet of 2 inch pipe to a 2' x 5' x 2' deep steel trough for stockwater purposes for 300 head of cattle within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, T.44N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
