CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard L. Hafen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 12 bears S. 54° 36' 53" E., a distance of 1833.8 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Woodrow P. Champion, Lillian S. Champion, John F. Champion and Evelyn E. Champion
Post-office address: Pahrump, Nevada

* Amount of appropriation: 0.267 c.f.s., but not to exceed 50.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

** Date of priority of appropriation: October 15, 1951

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 10.0 Acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined rate of diversion issued under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 45662 shall not exceed 0.267 c.f.s.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 13868, Certificate 5524, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 13868, Certificate 5524.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
