CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clayton R. Doak, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring No. 2

through a spring and distribution system for

Mining, Milling and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T.37N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 6 bears S. 54° 35' 30" E., a distance of 1288.75 feet

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clayton R. Doak, 1/2 interest William P. Harrison, 1/2 interest

Post-office address Carson City and Silver Springs, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.067 c.f.s., but not to exceed 48.5 acre-feet annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 21, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through a distribution system consisting of 1000 feet of ditch, 18 inches wide and 12 inches deep, to a small storage pond 40' x 50' x 6' deep for mining, milling and domestic purposes within portions of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NE 1/4 and SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, and a portion of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, T.37N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
