CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Fork Deer Creek Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T.43N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 30 bears N. 77° 30' W., a distance of 3460.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ronald M. Florence
Post-office address: Palos Verdes, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a fenced spring area via the West Fork Deer Creek for stockwater purposes for 800 head of cattle within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T.43N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
