CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12, T.35N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 12 bears S. 45° 18' E., a distance of 2580.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Raymond B. and Barbara Kearns

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0649 c.f.s., but not to exceed 28.0 acre-feet annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

*Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1964

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 7.0 Acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, T.35N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 30602 which changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 28597, Certificate 8608, which changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 24111 which changes the point of diversion of Permit 21770, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 21770.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
