CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Diamond Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T.18N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 25, T.18N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 67° 06' E., a distance of 14,775.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mark Lattin and Stanley Lattin
Post-office address: Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 7, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in the well, thence via an Aeromotor Windmill system the water is pumped through 15 feet of 2 inch pipeline to two 2,750 gallon troughs where 500 cattle are watered within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 34, T.18N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
