CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tunnel Spring through a ditch and distribution system for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 13, T.17N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 13 bears S. 56° 55' E., a distance of 6145.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mark Lattin & Stanley Lattin
Post-office address: Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.001 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 7, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence via an Aeromotor Windmill system the water is pumped through 100 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipeline to a 1,000 gallon trough where 500 cattle are watered within the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, T.17N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
