CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 17 bears N. 88° 02' 24" W., a distance of 1515.99 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bell Telephone Company of Nevada

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0226 c.f.s., but not to exceed 9150.00 gallons per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 30, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed via a distribution system and used to humidify electronic telephone equipment within a portion of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 17, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
