CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 1 bears N. 85° 19' 40" E., a distance of 2284.39 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Co., Inc.

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.134 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.810 million gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a drilled well via a storage pressure tank and pumped through a pipeline distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes to serve nine residences, garage, barn, and farmstead corral within the E 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, T.9N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
