CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan F. Walters, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 30 bears S. 51° 59' 01" E., a distance of 1,234.16 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Las Vegas Valley Water District
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.15 c.f.s., but not to exceed 271.233 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation November 30, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped into a distribution system within the boundaries of the Las Vegas Valley Water District, Clark County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 20182, Certificate 5782, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 20182, Certificate 5782.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
