CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears S. 35° 07' 18" E., a distance of 863.19 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Nevada Green
Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.163 c.f.s., but not to exceed 38.453 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 27, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a 100 foot deep drilled well, 6 inch casing, equipped with a Gondolf submersible pump and motor, thence the water is conveyed via a pipeline to heat a greenhouse within a portion of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. After the heat extraction process, the fluids are discharged into the Humboldt River.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
