CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert J. McNutt, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial (Manufacturing) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears N. 63° 47' 26" W., a distance of 907.40 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.049 c.f.s., but not to exceed 11.64 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation December 26, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from an 815 foot deep well, 10-3/8 inch casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. Lane & Bowler pump, thence the water is conveyed via a 6,000 gallon storage tank to the place of use within the W 1/2 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 11472, Certificate 3276, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11472, Certificate 3276.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
