CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joseph Jeanney, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ackler Creek through headgate and ditch system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T.36N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from the NW corner of said Section 25 bears SE 2,574.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
