CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, windmill and stockwater trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T.31N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 22 bears N. 22° 30' 10" E., a distance of 2,301.04 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Saval Estate
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0423 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1500 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 6 inch casing, equipped with a windmill, thence the water is conveyed to a 20 foot diameter by 2 foot deep steel stockwatering trough to water 1500 head of cattle within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 22, T.31N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
