CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Creek Spring through a developed spring and stockwatering trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 31N., R. 41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 8 bears S. 82° 02' E., a distance of 3,285.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Saval Estate
Post-office address: Battle Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0223 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 17, 1984

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a developed spring, 18 inch diameter concrete culvert pipe placed vertically in the spring area, thence the water is conveyed via a 2 inch diameter plastic pipeline to a 24 inch wide by 20 foot long by 12 inch deep water trough where 800 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 31N., R. 41E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
