CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Molini, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Illipah Creek through Illipah Reservoir for Public Recreation, Fish and Wildlife habitat purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T.17N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 13 bears S. 15° 30' 09" E., a distance of 1,198.0 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joseph C. Greenley, Director Nevada Department of Wildlife
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 160 acre-foot storage, nonconsumptive use
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 30, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from Illipah Creek into Illipah Reservoir where 160 acre-feet of water is stored to maintain a minimum pool for public recreation, fish and wildlife habitat purposes within the SE 1/4 Section 13, and NE 1/4 Section 24, all in T.17N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
