CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. M. "Jim" Nelson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Fire Protection and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 3, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 3 bears S. 04° 13' 20" E., a distance of 655.98 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States of America, Forest Service
Post-office address: Sparks, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.1 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.110 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 27, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well 370 feet deep, 6-5/8 inch casing via a submersible pump and two 110 gallon storage tanks through a 3/4 inch pipeline distribution system for fire protection and domestic purposes at the Nevada Division of Forestry Lee Canyon Fire Station Area located within portions of Lot 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) Section 2 and Lot 9 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 3, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, and all that portion situated south of Lot 7 and Tract 40 in the SW 1/4 Section 2, all within T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
