CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald Nonella, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Buffalo Creek through the natural stream channel for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T.16N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 33 bears N. 44° 35' 39" W., a distance of 4,139.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 19, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is beneficially used within the natural stream channel to serve 100 head of cattle for stockwatering purposes within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, T.16N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
